ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT to the ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

received the vote of a majority of the directors in office.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Colorado Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation: Association of Graduates FIRST: The name of the corporation is of the United States Air Force Academy SECOND: The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted on the $19\underline{68}$, in the manner prescribed by the Colorado 3rd day of July Nonprofit Corporation Act, according to the procedure marked with an X below: a quorum of members was present at such meeting, and the amendment received at least two-thirds of the votes which members present or represented by proxy were entitled to cast. x such amendment was adopted by a consent in writing signed by all members entitled to vote with respect thereto. there are no members, or no members entitled to vote thereon, such amendment

Amendment Number 1.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Secretary of the Air Force for the use and benefit of the United States Air Force Academy, or, in the event of the non-existence of the United States Air Force Academy, for the use and benefit of other similiar United States Air Force organizations which are operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organic zation or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Iaw) as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Amendment Number 2.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future

United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to
which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ASSOCIATION OF GRADUATES OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY

(A Non-Profit Corporation)

We the undersigned, being over the age of twenty-one years and acting as incorporators of a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 327, Session Laws of Colorado, 1967, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is ASSOCIATION OF GRADUATES
OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY.

ARTICLE II.

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is to promote interest in and dedication to the ideals, objectives, activities and history of the United States Air Force Academy; the encouragement of study at the United States Air Force Academy of worthy young men; the fostering of fellowship and brotherhood among the graduates of the United States Air Force Academy, and in particular among the United States Armed Forces Officers' Corps in general; the continued professional development of the Armed Forces Officers' Corps to include the promotion of professional dialogue among its members, as well as among all U. S. Armed Forces Officers, in support of the military profession; to promote other activities in the general interest of the United States Air Force Academy or the membership

of this corporation in keeping with the above objectives and in order to carry out the objectives enumerated above. The corporation shall at no time be used in any way to support or oppose any political idea, organization or candidate.

ARTICLE IV.

The initial By-Laws of the corporation shall be adopted by its board of directors. The power to alter, amend or repeal the By-Laws, or to adopt new By-Laws, shall be vested in the board of directors.

ARTICLE V.

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be: c/o Captain Charles F. Stebbins, Quarters 4207F, United States Air Force Academy, Colorado, 80840, and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation is Captain Charles F. Stebbins at the above address.

ARTICLE VI.
